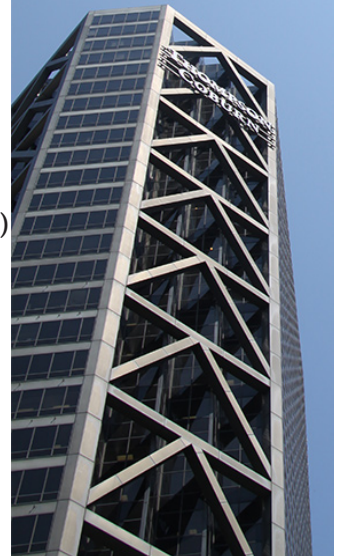

She brings a wealth of real-world experience from her 42-year career, having served with distinction as a Contracting Officer, Division Chief, Deputy Director Small Business and Director of Contracts at the Naval Research Laboratory, Military Sealift Command, Small Business Administration, Naval Sea Systems Command, and the Army Contracting Command.

She is an NCMA Fellow who has received numerous awards and recognitions and has earned both the Certified Professional Contract Manager (CPCM) and Certified Federal Contract Manager (CFCM) designations.
